COOKIE POLICY

The Company **Airport Handling S.p.A.**, with registered office in Somma Lombardo (VA), Aeroporto Milano Malpensa Terminal 2 (hereinafter also referred to as "**Airport Handling**" or the "**Company**") provides the following information on the processing of the browsing data and on the cookies of the <http://www.airporthandling.eu/> (hereinafter also referred to as the "**Website**"), also pursuant to the Decree of the Italian Data Protection Authority "*Simplified Arrangements to Provide Information and Obtain Consent Regarding Cookies*" of 8th May 2014 (hereinafter also referred to as the "**Decree**").

The following notice refers to the Website and not to other websites of third parties that may be consulted by the user through links.

This Policy shall be read in addition to the Privacy Policy, available at the following link <http://www.airporthandling.eu/docs/AH-Privacy-Policy-2019-en.pdf> to which we refer for any other information on the policy adopted by the Company in the management of the Website.

A. Purpose of processing

The Company may collect and process, during your browsing of the Website, certain information, also by automatic means such as through the installation of cookies in the client or in the user's device to provide and complete the various services and features offered by the Website.

The following are the related processing methods.

B. Processing methods

1. Browsing data

The IT systems and software procedures responsible for the operation of the Website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of the Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected in order to be associated with identified persons, but in light of its nature they could, through processing with data held by third parties, allow to identify the users.

This category of data includes the IP address and the domain names of the computers used by the users who connect to the Website, the URIs (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in the response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and the user's IT environment.

Such data are only used in order to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the Website and to check its correct operation and are immediately erased after the processing.

The data could also be used in order to determine a criminal liability, for instance in case of cybercrimes committed to damage the Website: except for this case, the data are stored for the period set forth in the relevant legal provisions, for the time strictly necessary to provide the user with the service required to ensure the transmission of communication.

2. Cookies

Cookies are short text files that are downloaded to the user's device when he/she visits a website.

At each subsequent visit, cookies are sent back to the website that originated them (first-party cookies) or to another website that recognizes them (third-party cookies).

Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize user's device.

They have different purposes such as, for example, allowing you to efficiently browse through the pages, remember user's favorite websites and, in general, improve the browsing experience.

Cookies also help to ensure that the advertising content displayed online is more targeted to the user and to his/her interests.

Information recorded on the user's device may be reused during the same visit to the Website (session cookies) or later, even after days (persistent cookies). Cookies are stored, according to the user's preferences, by the individual browser on the specific device used (computer, tablet, smartphone).

Depending on the function and purpose of use, it is possible to identify different types of cookies:

2.1. Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of performing IT authentication or monitoring sessions and storing specific technical information regarding the user who accesses the Website.

Among these technical cookies, we underline the so-called "essential cookies", also called "strictly necessary", which enable functions, that otherwise would make it impossible to fully use the Website.

These cookies are only used by the Company and therefore are first-party cookies. They are only stored on the user's computer during the current browser session. A cookie of this type is also used to store the user's decision on the use of cookies on the Website.

The essential cookies cannot be disabled by using the functions of the Website.

Technical cookies also include those used to statistically analyse the accesses to, or the visits to, the Website, also called "analytics". Such cookies are exclusively used for statistical purposes (but not for marketing or profiling purposes) and to collect information in aggregate form without the possibility of identifying the individual user.

The installation of these cookies does not require the prior consent of users. These cookies can be deactivated and/or deleted via the browser settings.

All modern browsers allow to change the settings of cookies. These settings can usually be found in the "options" or "preferences" menu of your browser.

In the event of a block on the use of cookies, the service offered to the user through the Website will be limited, thus affecting the use of the Website.

For each technical cookie used, the following information is provided: name, purpose of use and retention period

2.2. First-party profiling cookies

In addition to technical cookies, the Company informs the user that it also uses profiling cookies on the Website for the purpose of analysing user behaviour for marketing purposes. The use of these cookies requires the prior freely given and informed consent of the user, that the Website obtains at the conditions provided for by the Decree through the banner that appears on the first visit of the Website itself. The user's preferences regarding the installation of profiling cookies can be managed by the user through the above button.

Denying consent to the use of profiling cookies will not interfere with the possibility of accessing the Website, except for the impossibility of accessing those functions or content that make use of such cookies. In this case, a special communication will appear informing the user of this circumstance.

Please find below, for each profiling cookie used, its name, purpose of use and retention period.

2.3. Third-party cookies including profiling cookies

While browsing, the user may also receive cookies from different websites or web servers on his/her computer / device (the so-called "third-party" cookies): this is because there may be elements on the Website such as images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages of other domains that are located on servers other than the one on which the requested page is located.

In other words, these cookies are set directly by operators of websites or servers other than the Website. Such third parties may set cookies when you visit the Website and thus obtain information about the fact that you have visited the Website.

The following cookies also belong to third-party cookies, including profiling cookies

- Social Plugin: cookies installed by social buttons (Facebook, Twitter etc.) whose use is optional. The presence of these plugins involves the transmission of cookies to and from all websites managed by third parties. The management of the information collected by third parties is governed by the relevant information provided by said third parties, to which reference should be made.
- Widgets: graphical components of a user interface of a program, which aims to facilitate the user in interacting with the program itself. By way of example, widgets are facebook, google +, twitter cookies.
- Advertising: cookies used to advertise within the Website, such as Google and Tradedoubler.

Please find below, for each third-party cookie on the Website, the name, purpose, name of the third party that stores the information and the related link to the website of said third party, **which can be accessed to view the information on the processing of personal data provided by the third party and to withdraw your consent, if granted.**
